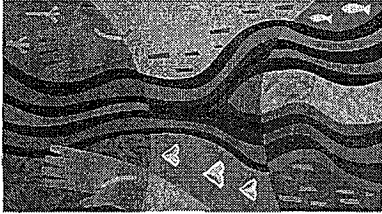

- Competition will be held **Friday, November 13, 2009**
- All entries must be cooked on site
- Teams and equipment must be in place before 12 noon with judging to be at 5:00 p.m. Turn in time for judging is plus or minus 15 minutes
- Teams will be notified as to the location of the judging booth. In any case the judging will take place near the cooking area.
- The cooking location will be on Front Street Downtown Morgan City
- All dishes must consist of a minimum of **100 – 2 oz.** samples
- Cooks/teams must supply their own heat source (butane cookers, etc. are to be used as electricity cannot be supplied to each booth.)
- Contestants must provide their own shelter, cover, tent, chairs, tables and presentation materials.
- Each team will turn in sufficient servings for 6 Judges, in Boxes provided. No distinguishing marks will appear on the outside of the box. Examples: if beef brisket is served the box should contain 6 full slices of brisket. If Chicken wings are served, 6 pieces of chicken wings are to be in the box. For Jambalaya or loose foods about 2 cups should be provided.
- No motor homes will be allowed on the cooking grounds.
- A Taster's choice will be held after the judging is completed
- Taster's choice bracelets will be sold to patrons wishing to sample foods provided for judging.
- The Festival will supply each booth with eating utensils, cups or dishes and napkins. The festival will handle the sale of Sampler's bracelets. No Bracelet, no food samples.
- Winnings will be determined by the number of participating teams.
- The winning teams will be announced at the 7:30 pm break.
- Participants shall make every effort to prepare and serve food in a safe and sanitary manner. Please store food appropriately.

The fest will provide you with bowls, napkins and forks. You must provide serving utensils. The contestants may plate the samples to be judged at the judges table just prior to serving. No electricity will be provided. Ribbons and prize money will be awarded as follows: \$100.00 First Place, \$50.00 Second Place and \$25.00 Third Place

- Competition in the shrimp cooking contest is open to anyone.
- Event is **Friday, November 13th**

- Recipes must be TYPED on 8-1/2" x 11" sheet of paper, including ingredients, cooking and/or baking times, directions and temperatures. The recipe MUST be turned in with your registration form.
- Prepared food entries will be accepted the day of the show during check-in times (MUST have pre-registered by November 12th, 2009 to compete).
- All exhibits MUST be homemade and the work of the person making the entry.
- It is strongly recommended that food entries be brought to the Festival on disposable plates, boards, pans, etc. Atchafalaya Culinary & Arts Festival or its representatives do not assume liability for broken or damaged serving containers.
- Articles will be tested to the satisfaction of the judges.
- Judging is based on TASTE, APPEARANCE and the RECIPE (how easy to follow and prepare).
- Contestants **MUST** be present to win.
- Contestants MUST be amateurs (professional cooks or those who earn a significant portion of their livelihood from preparing food for sale, may not enter).
- Recipes will be used to promote future events.
